Wisconsin would receive \$1.4 billion in education funding if the Senate passed the HEROES Act

The K-12 portion of these funds would provide Wisconsin \$915.3 million. That's enough to save or restore the positions of

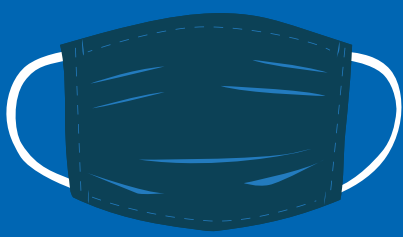

Wisconsin would receive \$8.5 billion in direct aid to states and \$7.2 billion in direct aid to local governments for frontline public service workers who are essential to fighting this pandemic and reopening our economy.
